

#### **About The Survey**

The Partnership for Downtown Rochester (PDR) conducted a community survey soliciting feedback on the draft district plan for a potential Downtown Rochester BID from 11/28/2023 to 12/31/2023. Respondents were asked to rate various elements of the plan in order of importance, and share additional feedback on the contents of the plan. The draft district plan outlined potential services a Downtown Rochester BID could offer, and how it would be managed. The survey was offered in both English and Spanish and was available digitally and in-person. In addition to digital outreach, the Partnership conducted 2 pop-up events, and 5 downtown residential tabling events. A summary of data collected follows below.



In your opinion, please rank the service areas from the draft district plan in order of importance.




In your opinion, which types of events and activations should be prioritized? (Select all that apply.)






With regards to small business support and livability, which proposed efforts do you think are most important?


In the context of hospitality services, which offerings do you value the most? (Select all that apply)






In your opinion, please rank the focus areas outlined in the draft Ambassador Code of Conduct (Page 21 in the draft District Plan) in order of importance.




